## THE GAME

- » Friday's game is the second of the year for the Blue Hens as they participate in the consolation round of the Preseason WNIT.
- » The winner of Friday's game will take on the winner between Nicholls State and host Texas State on Saturday.
- » Delaware is competing in the Preseason WNIT for the fifth time (2000, 2002, 2007, 2012).
- » The Blue Hens travel to the state of Texas for just the second time in program history. Exactly 11 years ago, Delaware faced TCU in Fort Worth as part of the Preseason WNIT on November 16, 2007.

#### THE SERIES

» Delaware and Montana State have never met in women's basketball history.

## THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her second season at Delaware after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach.
- » Tricia Binford (Boise State '95) is in her 14<sup>th</sup> season as the head coach of the Bobcats. The 2015-16 Big Sky Coach of the Year, Binford has led Montana State to two BSC regular season titles with trips to the NCAA Tournament and Postseason WNIT.

# **LAST TIME OUT**

Jasmine Dickey made sure everyone knew her name last Friday night as the freshman posted a double double in her collegiate debut. Unfortunately, it wasn't enough as the Blue Hens fell to Northern Iowa, 79-67, in the Preseason WNIT at the McLeod Center. Dickey finished the night with 21 points, 12 rebounds and one steal in 29 minutes of action. The Baltimore, Md. native went 8-of-21 (.381) from the field to go along with five free throws to lead Delaware. In total, the Hens saw four players with double figure scoring efforts as Abby Gonzales and Samone DeFreese added 12 and 11 points, respectively, while freshman Paris McBride contributed 10 of her own. The Panthers (1-0) took advantage of free throws and registered 26 points from the charity stripe. Karli Rucker led UNI with 25 points and six assists while Megan Maahs recorded 17 points and 10 rebounds.

#### JASMINE DICKEY MAKES A SPLASH IN DEBUT; NAMED CAA ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Blue Hens guard *Jasmine Dickey* made a splash in her Delaware debut last Friday and was rewarded with her efforts Monday as the Colonial Athletic Association named her the league's Rookie of the Week. Dickey logged 21 points and 12 rebounds in the first round of the Preseason WNIT at Northern Iowa and joined rare company with her stat line. The Baltimore, Md. native is the first Delaware freshman since *Nicole Enabosi* (2015) to post a double double in her collegiate debut and scored the most points in a season opener for the Blue Hens since *Elena Delle Donne* collected 33 in 2011. Additionally, Dickey is the first Delaware freshman to post 20-plus points in her collegiate debut since *Anette Percy* registered 21 points in 1994 and is believed to be the first Blue Hen to record 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds in her first-ever game at Delaware.

#### DELAWARE KICKS OFF 48TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

The 2018–19 season marks the 48<sup>th</sup> overall in the history of the University of Delaware women's basketball program. During their previous 47 years, the Blue Hens have registered a mark of 762–506 (.601) with 31 winning seasons under four head coaches. Last season, Delaware hit 19 wins for the first time since the 2013–14 campaign when UD was 20–11 overall. Entering the year, Delaware averaged 16.2 wins per in the previous 46 seasons. The Hens had also not won more than 10 CAA games since going 18–0 in 2012–13.

## CAA PRESEASON RANKINGS/HONORS

Delaware is predicted to finish third in the Colonial Athletic Association Preseason Poll with 61 points while James Madison was predicted to win it all in 2019 with 79 points and seven first place votes. Blue Hens junior **Samone DeFreese** was picked as a Preseason All-CAA Second Team honoree. DeFreese, a starter a season ago and two-time letter winner for Delaware, saw action in all 32 games last year and was ranked 11th in the CAA with 7.4 rebounds per

#### **FRESH FACES**

Delaware welcomes three newcomers to the team while graduating three seniors from last season. Freshmen *Lolo Davenport*, *Jasmine Dickey* and *Paris McBride* join the Hens from successful high school campaigns. Following their NLI signings, head coach *Natasha Adair* stated: "I'm really thrilled with this class. My first recruiting class at the University of Delaware has really shaped out to be a big one. We are signing some of the top players in the country, but the most important thing is that they are all character-first people. And that's a big reason why they're here. They fit into what we're doing, they fit the chemistry of our current players and they'll also help take us to the next level."

#### **NICHOLAS IS BACK**

Nearly 11 months after seeing the court for the Blue Hens due to injury, *Makeda Nicholas* will return to the floor against Northern Iowa in her final year of eligibility. Nicholas graduated in May from UD with a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology and is currently studying to obtain a Master of Arts degree in education. The forward is currently fifth in the Delaware career record books with 126 blocks, 24<sup>th</sup> all-time with 524 rebounds and 53<sup>rd</sup> overall with 581 points and is the team's active career leader with 98 games played.

#### BLUE HENS WITHOUT CAA PLAYER OF THE YEAR; TOP RECRUIT

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as *Nicole Enabosi*, the 2018 CAA Player of the Year, and incoming freshman *Lolo Davenport* underwent surgery for ACL injuries. Both will return for Delaware during the 2019-20 campaign.

## **DELAWARE TO HOST 2019 CAA TOURNAMENT AT BOB CARPENTER CENTER**

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returns to the Bob Carpenter Center for the first time since 2008 with competition being held March 13-16. The tournament was held on campuses prior 2010 before moving to the Show Place Arena in 2011, where it entertained fans for five seasons. James Madison University hosted the tournament in 2017 while Drexel University hosted in 2018.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goal made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and currently serves as an assistant coach for the U18 Women's National Basketball Team and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
