- » Delaware looks to rebound from a disappointing conference-opening loss to James Madison.
- » The Blue Hens are looking for their first win of 2019.

THE SERIES

- $_{\rm ^{9}}$ One of the longest rivalries in program history, Sunday's game is the 77th all-time matchup between the two teams dating to the 1973-74 season.
- » Delaware leads Towson all-time, 55-21, and has won 15 of the last 16 vs. the Tigers.
- » UD is 29-8 over TU in Newark and has won 10 straight at the Bob Carpenter Center.
- » Towson's last road win against the Hens came on Feb. 21, 2008 by a score of 51-49.

THE COACHES

- » *Natasha Adair* (South Florida '94) is in her second season at Delaware after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach.
- » Adair is nearing 100 victories as a head coach and currently sits at 96 during her seven-year tenure.
- » Diane Richardson (Frostburg '80) is in her second season as the head coach at Towson. Most recently, Richardson was an assistant coach and the recruiting coordinator at West Virginia from 2016–17

LAST TIME OUT

Delaware opened Colonial Athletic Association play Friday evening with a disappointing 68-43 loss to James Madison at the Bob Carpenter Center. The Blue Hens (5-8, 0-1 CAA) were wounded by poor shooting as UD registered season-lows in points (43), field goal percentage (.254), field goals made (17), 3-point field goal percentage (.091) and free throw percentage (.364). *Makeda Nicholas* led the Hens with nine points while *Rebecca Lawrence* tallied eight points and six rebounds. *Jasmine Dickey* and *Samone DeFreese* each added six points and six rebounds for Delaware while Dickey also finished with two assists and two steals.

LAST TIME VS. TOWSON | MARCH 3, 2018 | SECU ARENA

Delaware closed regular season play on a high note as the Blue Hens cruised to an 81-55 triumph over Towson. With the win, UD entered the CAA Tournament with an overall record of 18-11 while going 11-7 in conference action. *Nicole Enabosi* registered her 22nd double-double of the season by finishing with 22 points and 10 rebounds to go along with three assists and three steals. *Samone DeFreese* added 19 points, seven rebounds, three steals and two assists. All nine Blue Hens who played recorded at least four points each. Delaware used a 15-0 run to close out the first quarter while shooting .714 (10-for-14) from the floor.

LAST TIME AT HOME VS. TOWSON | JANUARY 14, 2018 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

It was a nail biter throughout, but in the end Delaware gutted out the 51-49 victory over Towson. The win marked a season-best fourth straight for the Hens, who moved to 11-5 overall and 4-1 in CAA play. The Tigers held a one-point lead with 13 seconds remaining in regulation before *Abby Gonzales* drained the go-ahead 3-pointer off a kick-out pass from *Nicole Enabosi*. Enabosi knocked down two free throws with three seconds left on the clock to seal the victory. Gonzales and Enabosi each finished with 14 points while Enabosi grabbed 10 rebounds for her 12th double double of the year to go along with five blocked shots. Gonzales added a game-high five assists for the Hens. *Samone DeFreese* followed with her second straight game of 11 rebounds. UD held a 12-6 advantage in assists and also blocked nine shots to Towson's seven.

CAA PRESEASON RANKINGS/HONORS

Delaware is predicted to finish third in the CAA Preseason Poll with 61 points while James Madison was predicted to win it all in 2019 with 79 points and seven first place votes. Blue Hens junior **Samone DeFreese** was picked as a Preseason All-CAA Second Team honoree. In 11 games played this season, DeFreese currently ranks in the Top 30 of five different CAA statistical categories (seventh, 45.6 field goal percentage; 12th, 3.9 defensive rebounds per game; 14th, 6.0 rebounds per; 15th, 2.1 offensive rebounds per; 26th, 9.0 points per).

BLUE HENS IN THE COLONIAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

Delaware is 204-101 (.669) all-time in CAA regular season play with a 25-16 (.610) mark in the CAA Tournament and two conference titles (2012, 2013). Head coach *Natasha Adair*, who spent one season in the CAA at the College of Charleston is 20-15 against CAA foes.

DELAWARE TO HOST 2019 CAA TOURNAMENT AT BOB CARPENTER CENTER

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returns to the Bob Carpenter Center for the first time since 2008 with competition being held March 13-16. The tournament was held on campuses prior 2010 before moving to the Show Place Arena in 2011, where it entertained fans for five seasons. James Madison University hosted the tournament in 2017 while Drexel University hosted in 2018.

JASMINE DICKEY - A FOUR-TIME CAA ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOREE

In her first season as a collegiate student-athlete, Jasmine Dickey was named the CAA Rookie of the Week for the first three weeks possible and added another award on Dec. 31. Dickey logged 21 points and 12 rebounds in the first round of the Preseason WNIT at Northern Iowa and joined rare company with her stat line. The Baltimore, Md. native is the first Delaware freshman since Nicole Enabosi (2015) to post a double double in her collegiate debut and scored the most points in a season opener for the Blue Hens since Elena Delle Donne collected 33 in 2011. Additionally, Dickey is the first Delaware freshman to post 20-plus points in her collegiate debut since Anette Percy registered 21 points in 1994 and is believed to be the first Blue Hen to record 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds in her first-ever game at UD.

MAKEDA NICHOLAS CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

Nearly 11 months after seeing the court for the Blue Hens due to injury, Makeda Nicholas returned to the floor against Northern lowa in her final year of eligibility. Nicholas graduated in May from UD with a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology and is currently studying to obtain a Master of Arts degree in education. The forward is currently fifth in the Delaware career record books with 148 blocks, 19th all-time with 583 rebounds, 25th with 110 games played and 45th overall with 679 points.

DELAWARE VS. FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS

Through the first 10 games of the season, the Blue Hens faced five first-time opponents. Prior to this year, UD had never matched up against Northern Iowa, Montana State, Nicholls, UCF or Gardner-Webb

BLUE HENS PILING ON FREQUENT FLYER MILES

From November 8 to December 6, the Blue Hens played eight straight games on the road to open the season. In total, Delaware took 12 flights, visited seven different airports and logged approximately 9,700 miles round-trip by air and bus.

BLUE HEN HELPERS

Delaware's 26 assists at Delaware State on November 20 is good to tie for sixth in program single-game history and is the most for the Hens since posting 27 against Delaware State on December 10, 1992. UD's all-time record is 28 assists versus Drexel (February 8, 1992) and Kent State (November 24, 1989). Most recently, the Hens dished out 24 assists against Boston University on November 19, 2017.

SCORING MACHINE VS. DELAWARE STATE

UD's 85 points at Delaware State (November 20) is the most in regulation for the Blue Hens since an 85-71 victory over the College of Charleston on February 14, 2014.

LEFFT COMES UP BIG AT DELAWARE STATE

The biggest spark of the night against the Hornets may have been provided by Gadson Lefft. The redshirt senior scored her first career points in a Blue Hens uniform and finished the night with 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting from the field and a mark of 3-for-3 from the charity stripe. Lefft added a career-high six rebounds, two assists and two steals in 16 minutes of action. Additionally, nine straight points from the forward in the third turned the tides as Delaware (2-2) took the lead and never looked back in the win.

CAREER GAMES FOR GONZALES

Abby Gonzales has posted back-to-back 20-plus point games for the first time in her career. The guard put up a career-high 20 points against Nicholls State (November 17) before upping her career-best to 21 versus Delaware State (November 20). Entering the season, Gonzales' career-high was 18 against Saint Peters on November 25, 2017.

BLUE HENS CRASH THE BOARDS AGAINST NICHOLLS

Delaware registered 50 rebounds against Nicholls on November 17 for the eighth time since 2013. The Blue Hens most recently tallied 50 rebounds on January 26, 2018 against Northeastern

MAKEDA NICHOLAS PLAYS IN 100TH CAREER GAME

In November 17's win over Nicholls, graduate student *Makeda Nicholas* played in her 100th career game for the Blue Hens. Including Nicholas, 42 women's basketball players haves suited up for at least 100 games at the University of Delaware. Danielle Parker (2008-13) holds the program record with 144 career games played.

BLUE HENS ADD AGNES PAUL AND BRYNN WADE FOR 2019-20 CAMPAIGN

Natasha Adair excitedly announced November 16 that Agnes Paul and Brynn Wade have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2019-20. Paul, a 6-2 power forward from Bowie, Md. led New Hope Academy to a 18-13 record and a NACA runner-up finish under head coach Sam Caldwell a year ago. As a junior, Paul led NHA with 240 rebounds and was named to the NACA All-Tournament Team. She is a member of Team Durant AAU squad and also the Nigerian 17U National Team. Wade will join the Blue Hens from Gilbert, Ariz. where she is a 6-1 power forward for head coach Kyle Pedersen at Gilbert High School. She also played at La Cueva High and Hope Christian High in New Mexico and is a member of the New Mexico Heat Elite and Arizona Select AAU teams. "We are more than excited to welcome Agnes and Brynn into the Blue Hens family," Adair commented. "Both are tireless workers and flat out tough players. The future is bright for both Agnes and Brynn and I cannot wait to see them don that Delaware uniform next season."

DELAWARE KICKS OFF 48TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

The 2018-19 season marks the 48th overall in the history of the University of Delaware women's basketball program. During their previous 47 years, the Blue Hens have registered a mark of 762-506 (.601) with 31 winning seasons under four head coaches. Last season, Delaware hit 19 wins for the first time since the 2013-14 campaign when UD was 20-11 overall. Entering the year, Delaware averaged 16.2 wins per in the previous 46 seasons. The Hens had also not won more than 10 CAA games since going 18-0 in 2012-13.

FRESH FACES

Delaware welcomes three newcomers to the team while graduating three seniors from last season. Freshmen Lolo Davenport, Jasmine Dickey and Paris McBride join the Hens from successful high school campaigns. Following their NLI signings, head coach Natasha Adair stated: "I'm really thrilled with this class. My first recruiting class at the University of Delaware has really shaped out to be a big one. We are signing some of the top players in the country, but the most important thing is that they are all character-first people. And that's a big reason why they're here. They fit into what we're doing, they fit the chemistry of our current players and they'll also help take us to the next level."

BLUE HENS WITHOUT CAA PLAYER OF THE YEAR; TOP RECRUIT

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as Nicole Enabosi, the 2018 CAA Player of the Year, and incoming freshman Lolo Davenport underwent surgery for ACL injuries. Both will return for Delaware during the 2019-20 campaign.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goal made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and currently serves as an assistant coach for the U18 Women's National Basketball Team and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990–92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004–12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998–04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
