### THE GAME

- » The Blue Hens look to make it two straight wins in conference play following Friday's victory at Hofstra.
- » Delaware is making its first-ever appearance in Matthews Arena.

#### THE SERIES

- » Delaware holds the all-time series advantage of 38–15 over Northeastern and has won 31 of the last 36 against the Huskies.
- » The Blue Hens are 13-12 against the Huskies in Boston and last defeated NU in Beantown in 2015 (58-54).
- » The Hens snapped a three-game losing streak to the Huskies with their 61-50 victory in the CAA quarterfinals last season
- » The two teams wrap the regular season series in Newark on February 15.

### THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her second season at Delaware after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach.
- » Adair is nearing 100 victories as a head coach and currently sits at 97 during her seven-year tenure.
- » *Kelly Cole* (Northwestern '91) is in her fifth season as the head coach at Northeastern and is 59-78 all-time with the Huskies.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

The Blue Hens captured their first Colonial Athletic Association victory of the season Friday afternoon with a 78-59 decision over Hofstra at the Mack Sports Complex. Delaware (6-10, 1-3 CAA) bounced back from three straight games of poor shooting performances to go 30-of-62 (.484) from the field for its second-highest shooting percentage of the season so far. The Blue Hens received at least two points and one rebound from every player who saw playing time while Samone DeFreese led the way with 19 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the floor. DeFreese added eight rebounds in the win. Makeda Nicholas contributed 12 points, eight rebounds and four assists while Jasmine Dickey logged her fourth career double double after finishing the day with 11 points and 11 rebounds

LAST TIME VS. NORTHEASTERN | MARCH 8, 2018 | CAA QUARTERS | DASKALAKIS ATHLETIC CENTER A balanced attack led No. 5 Delaware to a 61-50 win over No. 4 Northeastern in the CAA quarterfinals. All five starters for the Blue Hens scored at least five points while CAA Player of the Year Nicole Enabosi posted her 23rd double-double of the year as she finished the game with 16 points and 14 rebounds to go along with five assists, three blocked shots and three steals. Abby Gonzales added 13 points while Samone DeFreese collected 11 points, seven rebounds and two steals and Rebecca Lawrence logged nine points, three rebounds and three blocks. Delaware tied a program and CAA Tournament record by holding Northeastern to just three points in the second quarter. The Hens previously held Marist to three points in the fourth quarter on November 19, 2015. NU's one field goal in the second quarter also set a CAA Tournament record.

### LAST TIME AT NORTHEASTERN | FEBRUARY 4, 2018 | CABOT CENTER

The Blue Hens were unable to hold on to an early lead their 73-59 loss to Northeastern. Delaware (13-8, 6-4 CAA) led by as much as six in the second quarter, but the Huskies (12-10, 7-4) combined a 54.0 shooting percentage from the field and a plus-15 rebounding margin to take sweep the regular season series. Bailey Kargo guided the Hens with 18 points while Nicole Enabosi registered 10 points and seven rebounds. With the win, Northeastern swept the regular season series against Delaware for the first time since 1998 when the Huskies put up two wins in America East action.

### MATT JANUS NAMED NMSA DELAWARE SPORTSCASTER OF THE YEAR

For the third time in his career and second straight year, the National Sports Media Association has named Blue Hens broadcaster Matt Janus as the Delaware Sportscaster of the Year. The 2007 University of Delaware graduate is in the midst of his 10th campaign calling Blue Hens women's basketball on Fox Sports 1290 AM and 1410 WDOV, and his seventh as the team's primary play-by-play voice. Janus also does television work on both football and basketball broadcasts for the CAA and BIG EAST.

Cloud '64 as 2019 honorees. A native of Dover and 2003 graduate from Polytech High, Smith was the first University of Delaware women's basketball player to be drafted by the WNBA when she was picked 18th overall by the Phoenix Mercury in 2007. A two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year honoree and the first Delaware player to earn All-Region accolades, Smith holds the school record with 342 career steals and is third on the Blue Hens all-time scoring list with 1,635 points and fifth with 307 assists. Smith led the Hens to 92 wins, 55 Colonial Athletic Association victories and three postseason appearances, including a trip to the 2007 NCAA Tournament. Sarah Gause is the lone other Blue Hens women's basketball player to be recognized as she was inducted in 2010. The Delaware Basketball Hall of Fame was founded in 2007 by the Delaware Interscholastic Basketball Coaches Association.

#### BLUE HENS IN THE COLONIAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

Delaware is 205-103 (.666) all-time in CAA regular season play with a 25-16 (.610) mark in the CAA Tournament and two conference titles (2012, 2013). Head coach *Natasha Adair*, who spent one season in the CAA at the College of Charleston is 21-17 against CAA foes.

### **DELAWARE TO HOST 2019 CAA TOURNAMENT AT BOB CARPENTER CENTER**

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returns to the Bob Carpenter Center for the first time since 2008 with competition being held March 13-16. The tournament was held on campuses prior 2010 before moving to the Show Place Arena in 2011, where it entertained fans for five seasons. James Madison University hosted the tournament in 2017 while Drexel University hosted in 2018.

### JASMINE DICKEY - A FOUR-TIME CAA ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOREE

In her first season as a collegiate student-athlete, *Jasmine Dickey* was named the CAA Rookie of the Week for the first three weeks possible and added another award on Dec. 31. Dickey logged 21 points and 12 rebounds in the first round of the Preseason WNIT at Northern lowa and joined rare company with her stat line. The Baltimore, Md. native is the first Delaware freshman since *Nicole Enabosi* (2015) to post a double double in her collegiate debut and scored the most points in a season opener for the Blue Hens since *Elena Delle Donne* collected 33 in 2011. Additionally, Dickey is the first Delaware freshman to post 20-plus points in her collegiate debut since *Anette Percy* registered 21 points in 1994 and is believed to be the first Blue Hen to record 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds in her first-ever game at UD.

### MAKEDA NICHOLAS CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

Nearly 11 months after seeing the court for the Blue Hens due to injury, *Makeda Nicholas* returned to the floor against Northern lowa in her final year of eligibility. Nicholas graduated in May from UD with a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology and is currently studying to obtain a Master of Arts degree in education. The forward is currently fifth in the Delaware career record books with 151 blocks, 18th all-time with 611 rebounds, 20th with 113 games played and 45th overall with 710 points.

### **DELAWARE VS. FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS**

Through the first 10 games of the season, the Blue Hens faced five first-time opponents. Prior to this year, UD had never matched up against Northern Iowa, Montana State, Nicholls, UCF or Gardner-Webb.

### **BLUE HENS PILING ON FREQUENT FLYER MILES**

From November 8 to December 6, the Blue Hens played eight straight games on the road to open the season. In total, Delaware took 12 flights, visited seven different airports and logged approximately 9,700 miles round-trip by air and bus.

### **BLUE HEN HELPERS**

Delaware's 26 assists at Delaware State on November 20 is good to tie for sixth in program single-game history and is the most for the Hens since posting 27 against Delaware State on December 10, 1992. UD's all-time record is 28 assists versus Drexel (February 8, 1992) and Kent State (November 24, 1989). Most recently, the Hens dished out 24 assists against Boston University on November 19, 2017.

### **SCORING MACHINE VS. DELAWARE STATE**

UD's 85 points at Delaware State (November 20) is the most in regulation for the Blue Hens since an 85-71 victory over the College of Charleston on February 14, 2014.

### LEFFT COMES UP BIG AT DELAWARE STATE

The biggest spark of the night against the Hornets may have been provided by Gadson Lefft. The redshirt senior scored her first career points in a Blue Hens uniform and finished the night with 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting from the field and a mark of 3-for-3 from the charity stripe. Lefft added a career-high six rebounds, two assists and two steals in 16 minutes of action. Entering the season, Gonzales' career-high was 18 against Saint Peters on November 25, 2017.

### BLUE HENS ADD AGNES PAUL AND BRYNN WADE FOR 2019-20 CAMPAIGN

Natasha Adair excitedly announced November 16 that Agnes Paul and Brynn Wade have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2019-20. Paul, a 6-2 power forward from Bowie, Md. led New Hope Academy to a 18-13 record and a NACA runner-up finish under head coach Sam Caldwell a year ago. As a junior, Paul led NHA with 240 rebounds and was named to the NACA All-Tournament Team. She is a member of Team Durant AAU squad and also the Nigerian 17U National Team. 

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goal made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and currently serves as an assistant coach for the U18 Women's National Basketball Team and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.




