- » Delaware enters the final game of the regular season tied for third in the CAA.
- » The Blue Hens cannot finish lower than fifth in the league standings; please see page three for Delaware's tie-breaking scenarios.
- » UD has reached 11 conference wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2013.
- » The Hens have won six of its last seven games and 10 of its last 12.
- » James Madison clinched the CAA regular season title with its 58-47 win over Drexel Friday.

#### THE SERIES

- » This is the 39th meeting between Delaware and James Madison in women's basketball history.
- » The Dukes have won 13 straight over the Blue Hens and lead the all-time series, 25-13.
- » Earlier this season, the Hens suffered from a poor shooting effort in their 68-43 loss to JMU at the Bob Carpenter Center.
- » Delaware is 5-11 against James Madison in Harrisonburg.
- » The Blue Hens last won in Harrisonburg on February 10, 2013 with the 71-64 victory over the Dukes.
- » Delaware last defeated James Madison, 61-60, on February 24, 2013 at the Bob Carpenter Center.

# THE COACHES

- » Natasha Adair (South Florida '94) is in her second season at Delaware after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach.
- » Now in her seventh season, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach earlier this season at William & Mary.
- » Sean O'Regan (James Madison '03) is in his third season as the head coach at James Madison. O'Regan previously served the previous nine seasons as an assistant and associate head coach for the Dukes

# **LAST TIME OUT**

A 27-point fourth quarter sparked Delaware to its third straight win as the Hens topped Towson, 70-57, Thursday evening at SECU Arena. The Blue Hens (16-13, 11-6 CAA), who trailed by one entering the fourth quarter, outscored the Tigers, 27-13, in the final stanza and are now tied with Towson (17-11, 11-6 CAA) for third in the Colonial Athletic Association with one game remaining in the regular season. *Makeda Nicholas* led Delaware with 15 points, six rebounds and three assists while *Alison Lewis* tallied 14 points, five rebounds and two assists. *Jasmine Dickey*, who missed the previous seven games with a broken hand, returned to the floor where she led Catonsville High School to the 2017 Maryland state title to collect eight points and three rebounds in 11 minutes of action. LAST TIME VS. JAMES MADISON | FRIDAY, JANUARY 4, 2019 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER Delaware opened league play with a disappointing 68-43 loss to James Madison. The Blue Hens (5-8, 0-1 CAA) were wounded by poor shooting as UD registered season-lows in points (43), field goal percentage (.254), field goals made (17), 3-point field goal percentage (.091) and free throw percentage (.364). Makeda Nicholas led the Hens with nine points while Rebecca Lawrence tallied eight points and six rebounds. Jasmine Dickey and Samone DeFreese each added six points and six rebounds for Delaware while Dickey also finished with two assists and two steals

# LAST TIME AT JAMES MADISON | FEBRUARY 25, 2018 | JMU CONVOCATION CENTER

It was a back and forth affair, but JMU pulled away at the end to top Delaware, 67-56. In total, the game featured eight tied scores and six lead changes. *Nicole Enabosi* collected her sixth straight, and 21<sup>st</sup> overall, game with a double double and neared a career-high with 26 points and 12 rebounds to go along with three steals and a blocked shot in 37 minutes of play for the Blue Hens (17-10, 10-6 CAA). *Kiersten West* came off the bench to tally 10 points and four rebounds while *Abby Gonzales* notched five points, four assists and four rebounds.

If Delaware and Towson finish tied for third at 12-6, Delaware is the #3 seed and Towson is the #4 seed as Delaware wins the tiebreaker based on its 1-1 record against #1 James Madison. If Delaware and Towson finish tied for third at 11-7, Towson is the #3 seed and Delaware is the #4 seed as Towson wins the tie-breaker based on its 1-1 record against #2 Drexel.

If Delaware, Towson and UNCW finish tied for third at 11-7, UNCW is the #3 seed, Towson is the #4 seed and Delaware is the #5 seed. UNCW gets the #3 seed based on its 1-1 record versus #1 James Madison. Towson gets the #4 seed based on its 1-1 record versus #2 Drexel and Delaware is the #5 seed.

If Delaware and UNCW finish tied for fourth at 11-7, UNCW is the #4 seed and Delaware is the #5 seed. The teams split their head-to-head series but UNCW wins the tie-breaker based on its 1-1 record against #1 James Madison.

# ALISON LEWIS PROVIDING SPARK OFF THE BENCH

**Alison Lewis** has reached double figure scoring in six straight games and previously collected double figures just twice this season. In the past six games, the senior is averaging 14.2 points per game. In the 22 games prior, Lewis averaged 4.4 points per.

#### TRENDING IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

The Blue Hens started CAA play with an 0-3 record and were 5-10 at one point this season,. Delaware has won 10 of its last 12 and will now finish the regular season with a winning record and are guaranteed to wrap the year with at least a .500 winning percentage for the fourth straight season.

#### ABBY GONZALES FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Junior **Abby Gonzales** is nearing the Delaware single-season record for three-point field goals made. Gonzales is currently tied for third overall with 58 treys alongside **Courtni Green** (2014-15) made while **Elena Delle Donne** holds the record of 66 made during the 2009-10 campaign.

#### REBECCA LAWRENCE REACHES BLOCKS MILESTONE

Junior **Rebecca Lawrence**, who is third in the CAA with 1.7 blocks per game this season, swatted her 100<sup>th</sup> career shot March 3 vs. William & Mary. She joins teammates **Nicole Enabosi** and **Makeda Nicholas** as three of only 10 Blue Hens to ever reach the century milestone.

### **DELAWARE CRASHES THE BOARDS VS. HOFSTRA**

Delaware broke a 19-year-old record against Hofstra by tallying 60 rebounds - the mostever rebounds for the Blue Hens at the Bob Carpenter Center. The Hens previously posted 59 rebounds against New Hampshire on January 2, 2000. Delaware last registered 60 rebounds in a game on November 14, 2014 at Lafayette.

# **NATASHA ADAIR COLLECTS CAREER-WIN 100**

Delaware head coach **Natasha Adair** collected her 100<sup>th</sup> career victory with Delaware's 70-59 win at William & Mary. Adair, who previously coached five total seasons at the College of Charleston and Georgetown University, has 34 wins in two seasons at the helm of the Hens.

#### **DELAWARE TO HOST 2019 CAA TOURNAMENT AT BOB CARPENTER CENTER**

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returns to the Bob Carpenter Center for the first time since 2008 with competition being held March 13-16. The tournament was held on campuses prior 2010 before moving to the Show Place Arena in 2011, where it entertained fans for five seasons. James Madison University hosted the tournament in 2017 while Drexel University hosted in 2018.

### JASMINE DICKEY - A FIVE-TIME CAA ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOREE

In her first season as a collegiate student-athlete, *Jasmine Dickey* was named the CAA Rookie of the Week for the first three weeks possible and added two more awards on Dec. 31 and Jan. 21 for a total of five weekly honors. *Nicole Enabosi* captured four Rookie of the Week honors during the 2015–16 season while *Elena Delle Donne* was named the CAA Rookie of the Week 10 times during the 2009–10 campaign.

# TYRESA SMITH '07 INDUCTED INTO DELAWARE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

The Blue Hens had their ninth and 10<sup>th</sup> representatives inducted into the Delaware Basketball Hall of Fame in January as *Tyresa Smith* '07 joined men's basketball alum *Pete Cloud* '64 as 2019 honorees. A native of Dover and 2003 graduate from Polytech High, Smith was the first University of Delaware women's basketball player to be drafted by the WNBA when she was picked 18th overall by the Phoenix Mercury in 2007. A two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year honoree and the first Delaware player to earn All-Region accolades, Smith holds the school record with 342 career steals and is third on the Blue Hens all-time scoring list with 1,635 points and fifth with 307 assists. Smith led the Hens to 92 wins, 55 Colonial Athletic Association victories and three postseason appearances, including a trip to the 2007 NCAA Tournament. *Sarah Gause* is the lone other Blue Hens women's basketball player to be recognized as she was inducted in 2010. The Delaware Basketball Hall of Fame was founded in 2007 by the Delaware Interscholastic Basketball Coaches Association.

# **DELAWARE VS. FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS**

Through the first 10 games of the season, the Blue Hens faced five first-time opponents. Prior to this year, UD had never matched up against Northern Iowa, Montana State, Nicholls, UCF or Gardner-Webb.

# **BLUE HENS PILE ON FREQUENT FLYER MILES**

From November 8 to December 6, the Blue Hens played eight straight games on the road to open the season. In total, Delaware took 12 flights, visited seven different airports and logged approximately 9,700 miles round-trip by air and bus.

### **BLUE HEN HELPERS**

Delaware's 26 assists at Delaware State on November 20 is good to tie for sixth in program single-game history and is the most for the Hens since posting 27 against Delaware State on December 10, 1992. UD's all-time record is 28 assists versus Drexel (February 8, 1992) and Kent State (November 24, 1989). Most recently, the Hens dished out 24 assists against Boston University on November 19, 2017.

# JASMINE DICKEY SHINES IN BLUE HENS DEBUT

Jasmine Dickey logged 21 points and 12 rebounds in the first round of the Preseason WNIT at Northern lowa and joined rare company with her stat line. The Baltimore, Md. native is the first Delaware freshman since Nicole Enabosi (2015) to post a double double in her collegiate debut and scored the most points in a season opener for the Blue Hens since Elena Delle Donne collected 33 in 2011. Additionally, Dickey is the first Delaware freshman to post 20-plus points in her collegiate debut since Anette Percy registered 21 points in 1994 and is believed to be the first Hen to record 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds in her first-ever game at UD.

# BLUE HENS ADD AGNES PAUL AND BRYNN WADE FOR 2019-20 CAMPAIGN

Natasha Adair excitedly announced November 16 that Agnes Paul and Brynn Wade have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2019-20. Paul, a 6-2 power forward from Bowie, Md. led New Hope Academy to a 18-13 record and a NACA runner-up finish under head coach Sam Caldwell a year ago. As a junior, Paul led NHA with 240 rebounds and was named to the NACA All-Tournament Team. She is a member of Team Durant AAU squad and also the Nigerian 17U National Team. Wade will join the Blue Hens from Gilbert, Ariz. where she is a 6-1 power forward for head coach Kyle Pedersen at Gilbert High School. She also played at La Cueva High and Hope Christian High in New Mexico and is a member of the New Mexico Heat Elite and Arizona Select AAU teams. "We are more than excited to welcome Agnes and Brynn into the Blue Hens family," Adair commented. "Both are tireless workers and flat out tough players. The future is bright for both Agnes and Brynn and I cannot wait to see them don that Delaware uniform next season."

#### **FRESH FACES**

Delaware welcomes three newcomers to the team while graduating three seniors from last season. Freshmen *Lolo Davenport*, *Jasmine Dickey* and *Paris McBride* join the Hens from successful high school campaigns. Following their NLI signings, head coach *Natasha Adair* stated: "I'm really thrilled with this class. My first recruiting class at the University of Delaware has really shaped out to be a big one. We are signing some of the top players in the country, but the most important thing is that they are all character-first people. And that's a big reason why they're here. They fit into what we're doing, they fit the chemistry of our current players and they'll also help take us to the next level."

### BLUE HENS WITHOUT CAA PLAYER OF THE YEAR; TOP RECRUIT

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as *Nicole Enabosi*, the 2018 CAA Player of the Year, and incoming freshman *Lolo Davenport* underwent surgery for ACL injuries. Both will return for Delaware during the 2019-20 campaign.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goal made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and currently serves as an assistant coach for the U18 Women's National Basketball Team and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
