TIGERS

THE GAME

» Delaware opens postseason play with a quarterfinals matchup against Towson.
» Thursday's pairing is just the second-ever matchup between the Blue Hens and Tigers in the CAA Tournament.
» UD is 25-15 all-time in the CAA Tournament and 14-1 in the quarterfinals round.
» Delaware enters the game having won three of the last four.
» UD has reached 11 conference wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2013.
» **Samone DeFreese** earned CAA All-Second Team honors while **Jasmine Dickey** was named to the CAA All-Rookie Team and **Abby Gonzales** received the prestigious Dean Ehlers Leadership and Sport Excellence Award.

THE SERIES

» One of the longest rivalries in program history, Thursday's game is the 79th all-time game between the two teams dating to the 1973-74 season.
» Delaware leads Towson all-time, 56-22, and has won 17 of the last 18 vs. the Tigers.
» UD is 29-9 over TU in Newark and has won 10 of the last 11 at the Bob Carpenter Center.
» A week ago, the Hens recorded the 70-57 victory over the Tigers following a 27-point fourth quarter.
» Earlier this year, TU topped UD, 56-48, at the Bob Carpenter Center.
» The Blue Hens are 0-1 against the Tigers in the CAA Tournament with the lone matchup resulting in a 40-37 Towson victory on March 12, 2009 in first round action at the JMU Convocation Center.

THE COACHES

» **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her second season at Delaware after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
» Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach.
» Now in her seventh season, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach earlier this season at William & Mary.
» **Diane Richardson** (Frostburg '80), the 2019 CAA Coach of the Year, is in her second season as the head coach at Towson.

LAST TIME OUT

Delaware held its own throughout the game, but in the end, rebounding hindered the Hens in Saturday's 56-51 loss to James Madison in the regular season finale at the JMU Convocation Center. Delaware led by as much as seven in the third quarter, but the Dukes (25-4, 17-1 CAA) took advantage of rebounding and free throw opportunities to claim victory. **Bailey Kargo** and **Lizzie Oleary** led the Hens with 12 points apiece while Oleary finished with a team-high seven rebounds. **Samone DeFreese** added seven points and six rebounds while Jasmine Dickey contributed six points and six rebounds.

LAST TIME VS. TOWSON | THURSDAY, MARCH 7, 2019 | SECU ARENA

A 27-point fourth quarter sparked Delaware to its third straight win as the Hens topped Towson, 70-57, last Thursday at SECU Arena. The Blue Hens (16-13, 11-6 CAA), who trailed by one entering the fourth quarter, outscored the Tigers, 27-13, in the final stanza. **Makeda Nicholas** led Delaware with 15 points, six rebounds and three assists while **Alison Lewis** tallied 14 points, five rebounds and two assists. **Jasmine Dickey**, who missed the previous seven games with a broken hand, returned to the floor where she led Catonsville High School to the 2017 Maryland state title to collect eight points and three rebounds in 11 minutes of action.

LAST TIME AT HOME VS. TOWSON | SUNDAY, JANUARY 6, 2019 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

For the second straight contest, the Hens suffered from poor shooting resulting in the 56-48 loss to Towson. UD (5-9, 0-2 CAA) logged a program-low 19.2 shooting percentage by going 15-of-78 from the floor. Delaware also posted a season-low with 15 field goals made. **Makeda Nicholas** collected a team-best 14 points with nine rebounds while **Jasmine Dickey** registered a game-high 13 rebounds. The loss was the first for the Blue Hens against the Tigers since January 2015 and the first at the Bob Carpenter Center versus Towson since February 2008.

GONZALES NAMED DEAN EHLERS LEADERSHIP AND SPORT EXCELLENCE AWARD WINNER

With the announcement of the league's postseason honors earlier this week, Delaware junior **Abby Gonzales** is just the second-ever Blue Hens player to gain recognition from the Colonial Athletic Association for her outstanding leadership on the court and in the classroom through the Dean Ehlers Leadership and Sport Excellence Award. The annual award is given to a men's and women's basketball student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity and sportsmanship in conjunction with his/her academic athletic achievement. **Stephanie Leon** previously earned the honor following the 2014 season. Gonzales, who leads the Hens in five statistical categories has been able to balance her academics and athletics to maintain a 3.56 GPA as an elementary education major. The guard is currently a fourth-grade student-teacher at McVey Elementary and spent the fall semester as a second-grade student-teacher at Newark Charter School.

BLUE HENS GARNER POSTSEASON ACCOLADES

Two additional Blue Hens were recognized by the CAA for their outstanding performances throughout the regular season. **Samone DeFreese** garnered CAA All-Second Team honors while **Jasmine Dickey** was selected to the CAA All-Rookie Team. DeFreese enters the post-season averaging a team-best 10.8 points per game while shooting .406 from the field and collecting 183 rebounds (64 off., 119 def.). The forward also leads the team in field goals made (113) and free throws made (73). She was tabbed as a Preseason All-CAA honoree and

tabbed the CAA Player of the Week on February 18. Dickey enjoyed a stellar rookie campaign despite missing eight games due to injury. In addition to guiding the Blue Hens, Dickey led all CAA rookies with 8.3 rebounds per game with a total of 118 rebounds. The guard/forward also posted the second-most points for CAA rookies at a clip of 7.9 per.

Dickey was tabbed as the CAA Rookie of the Week an astounding five times, including a streak of three straight. Her five Rookie of the Week nominations are the most by a Blue Hen since *Elena Delle Donne's* 10 nominations in 2009-10. Dickey is the eighth CAA player since 2002-03 to have at least five Rookie of the Week nominations.

TRENDING IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

The Blue Hens started CAA play with an 0-3 record and were 5-10 at one point this season. Delaware has won 10 of its last 13 and will finish the regular season with a winning record. The Hens have posted 11 conference wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2013. Delaware is guaranteed to wrap the year with at least a .500 overall winning percentage for the fourth straight season.

ABBY GONZALES FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Junior *Abby Gonzales* is nearing the Delaware single-season record for three-point field goals made. Gonzales is currently tied for third overall with 58 treys alongside *Courtnei Green* (2014-15) made while *Elena Delle Donne* holds the record of 66 made during the 2009-10 campaign. Gonzales is also third in single-season history with 165 three-point field goal attempts. Green holds the first (177; 2015-16) and second (170; 2014-15) slots.

ALISON LEWIS PROVIDING SPARK OFF THE BENCH

Alison Lewis has reached double figure scoring in six of the last seven games and previously collected double figures just twice this season. In the past seven games, the senior is averaging 12.1 points per game. In the 22 games prior, Lewis averaged 4.4 points per.

REBECCA LAWRENCE REACHES BLOCKS MILESTONE

Junior *Rebecca Lawrence*, who is third in the CAA with 1.7 blocks per game this season, swatted her 100th career shot March 3 vs. William & Mary. She joins teammates *Nicole Enabosi* and *Makeda Nicholas* as three of only 10 Blue Hens to ever reach the century milestone.

DELAWARE CRASHES THE BOARDS VS. HOFSTRA

Delaware broke a 19-year-old record against Hofstra by tallying 60 rebounds - the most-ever rebounds for the Blue Hens at the Bob Carpenter Center. The Hens previously posted 59 rebounds against New Hampshire on January 2, 2000. Delaware last registered 60 rebounds in a game on November 14, 2014 at Lafayette.

NATASHA ADAIR COLLECTS CAREER-WIN 100

Delaware head coach *Natasha Adair* collected her 100th career victory with Delaware's 70-59 win at William & Mary. Adair, who previously coached five total seasons at the College of Charleston and Georgetown University, has 34 wins in two seasons at the helm of the Hens.

TYRESA SMITH '07 INDUCTED INTO DELAWARE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

The Blue Hens had their ninth and 10th representatives inducted into the Delaware Basketball Hall of Fame in January as *Tyresa Smith* '07 joined men's basketball alum *Pete Cloud* '64 as 2019 honorees. A native of Dover and 2003 graduate from Polytech High, Smith was the first University of Delaware women's basketball player to be drafted by the WNBA when she was picked 18th overall by the Phoenix Mercury in 2007. A two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year honoree and the first Delaware player to earn All-Region accolades, Smith holds the school record with 342 career steals and is third on the Blue Hens all-time scoring list with 1,635 points and fifth with 307 assists. Smith led the Hens to 92 wins, 55 Colonial Athletic Association victories and three postseason appearances, including a trip to the 2007 NCAA Tournament. *Sarah Gause* is the lone other Blue Hens women's basketball player to be recognized as she was inducted in 2010. The Delaware Basketball Hall of Fame was founded in 2007 by the Delaware Interscholastic Basketball Coaches Association.

DELAWARE VS. FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS

Through the first 10 games of the season, the Blue Hens faced five first-time opponents. Prior to this year, UD had never matched up against Northern Iowa, Montana State, Nicholls, UCF or Gardner-Webb.

BLUE HENS PILE ON FREQUENT FLYER MILES

From November 8 to December 6, the Blue Hens played eight straight games on the road to open the season. In total, Delaware took 12 flights, visited seven different airports and logged approximately 9,700 miles round-trip by air and bus.

BLUE HEN HELPERS

Delaware's 26 assists at Delaware State on November 20 is good to tie for sixth in program single-game history and is the most for the Hens since posting 27 against Delaware State on December 10, 1992. UD's all-time record is 28 assists versus Drexel (February 8, 1992) and Kent State (November 24, 1989). Most recently, the Hens dished out 24 assists against Boston University on November 19, 2017.

JASMINE DICKEY SHINES IN BLUE HENS DEBUT

Jasmine Dickey logged 21 points and 12 rebounds in the first round of the Preseason WNIT at Northern Iowa and joined rare company with her stat line. The Baltimore, Md. native is the first Delaware freshman since **Nicole Enabosi** (2015) to post a double double in her collegiate debut and scored the most points in a season opener for the Blue Hens since **Elena Delle Donne** collected 33 in 2011. Additionally, Dickey is the first Delaware freshman to post 20-plus points in her collegiate debut since **Anette Percy** registered 21 points in 1994 and is believed to be the first Hen to record 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds in her first-ever game at UD.

BLUE HENS ADD AGNES PAUL AND BRYNN WADE FOR 2019-20 CAMPAIGN

Natasha Adair excitedly announced November 16 that **Agnes Paul** and **Brynn Wade** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2019-20. Paul, a 6-2 power forward from Bowie, Md. led New Hope Academy to a 18-13 record and a NACA runner-up finish under head coach Sam Caldwell a year ago. As a junior, Paul led NHA with 240 rebounds and was named to the NACA All-Tournament Team. She is a member of Team Durant AAU squad and also the Nigerian 17U National Team. Wade will join the Blue Hens from Gilbert, Ariz. where she is a 6-1 power forward for head coach Kyle Pedersen at Gilbert High School. She also played at La Cueva High and Hope Christian High in New Mexico and is a member of the New Mexico Heat Elite and Arizona Select AAU teams. "We are more than excited to welcome Agnes and Brynn into the Blue Hens family," Adair commented. "Both are tireless workers and flat out tough players. The future is bright for both Agnes and Brynn and I cannot wait to see them don that Delaware uniform next season."

FRESH FACES

Delaware welcomes three newcomers to the team while graduating three seniors from last season. Freshmen **Lolo Davenport**, **Jasmine Dickey** and **Paris McBride** join the Hens from successful high school campaigns. Following their NLI signings, head coach **Natasha Adair** stated: "I'm really thrilled with this class. My first recruiting class at the University of Delaware has really shaped out to be a big one. We are signing some of the top players in the country, but the most important thing is that they are all character-first people. And that's a big reason why they're here. They fit into what we're doing, they fit the chemistry of our current players and they'll also help take us to the next level."

BLUE HENS WITHOUT CAA PLAYER OF THE YEAR; TOP RECRUIT

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as **Nicole Enabosi**, the 2018 CAA Player of the Year, and incoming freshman **Lolo Davenport** underwent surgery for ACL injuries. Both will return for Delaware during the 2019-20 campaign.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and currently serves as an assistant coach for the U18 Women's National Basketball Team and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
