

THE COACHES

- » Natasha Adair (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.
- » Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recenty helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach
- » Charlie Buscaglia (Manhattan College '03) is in his fourth season as the head coach at Robert Morris.
- » A three-time Brenda Reilly NEC Coach of the Year (2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19), Buscaglia has led the Colonials to three NEC regular-season championships (2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19) and Two NEC Tournament championships (2017, 2019).

LAST TIME OUT

The Blue Hens started off hot, but George Washington grabbed momentum in the second half and held on for the 63-49 victory over Delaware Wednesday evening at the Bob Carpenter Center. **Abby Gonzales** led the Hens with 16 points, including four 3-pointers, to go along with four rebounds, four steals and an assist. **Jasmine Dickey** added 13 points and five rebounds while **Nicole Enabosi** posted five points and a game-high six rebounds for Delaware.

LAST TIME VS. ROBERT MORRIS | DECEMBER 1, 2016 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

Senior *Erika Brown* came through in the clutch as the guard put up a floater in the middle of the lane with four seconds remaining to give the Hens the 67-65 come-from-behind victory over Robert Morris. The Blue Hens, who trailed for nearly 36 minutes of the contest, never let the Colonials get out of reach and eventually took their first lead of the game with two minutes left in regulation. Delaware outscored RMU, 12-4, in the final 4:04 while Brown contributed seven of those 12 points. Brown finished the game with a season- and game-high 18 points in addition to two assists, one rebound and one steal. Sophomore *Nicole Enabosi* added her eighth career double double with 14 points and 11 rebounds to go along with three assists and two steals.

LAST TIME AT ROBERT MORRIS | DECEMBER 29, 2015 | CHARLES SEWALL CENTER

Delaware held Robert Morris within reach for the entirety of the game, but the Blue Hens were unable to take the lead in the waning minutes as the Colonials defeated UD, 53-50. Senior *Courtni Green* led the Blue Hens with 15 points and three assists in 40 minutes of play. With three 3-pointers against RMU, the guard also moved into fourth place in Delaware history with 146 career treys. For the second straight game, freshman *Nicole Enabosi* collected a game-high 11 rebounds to go along with seven points. The Hens (5-6) held a 26-25 lead to go into halftime and shot 62.5 percent (5-for-8) from behind the arc in the first half, but couldn't find their stroke in the second as they finished the game 6-for-18 (33.3 percent). The Colonials (6-5) outscored Delaware, 18-10, in the third quarter and despite a 14-10 advantage in the fourth, the Blue Hens were unable to come out with the victory.

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward *Nicole Enabosi* returned to the court after a nearly 16-month haitus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week Monday. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year this past weekend. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in Saturday's 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in Friday's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts. Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in Saturday's win over Santa Clara, *Abby Gonzales* became just the thirdever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. *Sue Whitfield* (1984–88) and *Bridget McCarthy* (1987–91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

GONZALES REACHES ASSISTS MILESTONE

Abby Gonzales became the sixth player in program history to reach 300 career assists with her 10-assist performance against Santa Clara on November 30. The senior guard currently sits with 303 in 99 career games played. Delaware Athletics Hall of Famer *Tyresa Smith* (2003-07) is in fifth place with 307 career helpers.

DELAWARE PICKS UP OVERTIME VICTORY AGAINST SANTA CLARA

UD's 81-80 win against Santa Clara was the first for the Blue Hens in overtime since a 56-55 decision at American on November 16, 2016. Delaware previously had lost four straight overtime and double overtime decisions since that 2016 contest.

ENABOSI MOVING UP IN CAREER RECORD BOOKS

With 45 points scored at the Titan Classic, *Nicole Enabosi* moved past *Lauren Carra* (2009-13) into 11th place in program history with 1,299 career points. *Erika Brown* is 10th all-time with 1,402 points scored from 2013-17.

BLUE HENS ADD TARA COUSINS AND TYI SKINNER FOR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara Cousins** and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2020-21. "We're excited to welcome both Tara and Tyi into the Blue Hens family. There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

DELAWARE KICKS OFF 49TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

The 2019-20 season marks the 49th overall in the history of the University of Delaware women's basketball program. During their previous 48 years, the Blue Hens have registered a mark of 778-521 (.599) with 32 winning seasons under four head coaches.

UD SLATED TO FINISH FOURTH IN CAA; DEFREESE AND ENABOSI EARN PRESEASON HONORS

The Blue Hens were predicted to finish fourth in the CAA Preseason Poll. Additionally, *Nicole Enabosi* and *Samone DeFreese* were picked as Preseason All-CAA honorees. Under third-year head coach *Natasha Adair*, the Blue Hens look to improve upon a 16-15 record from a season ago. UD returns four starters and seven letter winners from last season in addition to seeing Enabosi back on the court following ACL surgery that kept her out last year. The 2018 CAA Player of the Year, Enabosi earned Preseason First Team accolades. She finished her junior campaign ranked in the Top 10 of nine Delaware single-season categories while leading the CAA in points per game (18.0), rebounds per game (11.8) and defensive rebounds per game (8.9). A starter for the past two seasons, DeFreese was tabbed a Preseason Second Team selection. A CAA All-Second Team honoree last season, the forward the Blue Hens with 10.9 points per game and a 73.3 (77-for-105) free throw percentage.

In her third USA Basketball coaching experience, Delaware head coach *Natasha Adair* helped guide the Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand. Adair coached alongside Louisville head coach, Jeff Walz, and UCLA head coach, Cori Close. The trio led the 2018 USA Women's U18 National Team to a gold medal, earning the team a berth in the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as *Bailey Kargo*, one of the team's sharp-shooting leaders underwent surgery for an ACL injury.

It was a successful year for Blue Hens alumna *Elena Delle Donne* as she led the Washington Mystics to its first-ever WNBA title while becoming the first player in WNBA history to earn Most Valuable Player honors with two different teams (Chicago Sky, 2015).

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35–31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013–14, Adair guided The College to record of 19–15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
