THE SERIES

- » This is the 40th meeting between Delaware and James Madison in women's basketball history.
- » The Dukes have won 14 straight over the Blue Hens and lead the all-time series, 26-13.
- » Delaware is 7-10 against James Madison in Newark.
- » The Hens last defeated the Dukes, 61-60, on February 24, 2013 at the Bob Carpenter Center.
- » The two teams wrap the regular season series in Harrisonburg on March 1.

THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.
- » Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.
- » **Sean O'Regan** (James Madison '03) is in his fourth season as the head coach at James Madison. O'Regan previously served the previous nine seasons as an assistant and associate head coach for the Dukes.

LAST TIME OUT

The Blue Hens started off rough but quickly recovered and held on Sunday afternoon for the 65-56 victory at Elon. The Phoenix opened the game with the 11-2 advantage before Delaware turned things around and won three of the next four quarters to snap a three-game losing streak. **Nicole Enabosi** led all scorers with 21 points to go along with 11 rebounds for her 46th career double double, which ties her for second in program history alongside **Elena Delle Donne** (2009-13). **Jasmine Dickey** added her eighth double double of the season by finishing the game with 17 points and 12 rebounds while **Kayla Shaw** also picked up 17 points, including 15 from behind the 3-point arc.

LAST TIME VS. JMU AT HOME | FRIDAY, JANUARY 4, 2019 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

Delaware opened league play with a disappointing 68-43 loss to James Madison. The Blue Hens (5-8, 0-1 CAA) were wounded by poor shooting as UD registered season-lows in points (43), field goal percentage (.254), field goals made (17), 3-point field goal percentage (.091) and free throw percentage (.364). **Makeda Nicholas** led the Hens with nine points while **Rebecca Lawrence** tallied eight points and six rebounds. **Jasmine Dickey** and **Samone DeFreese** each added six points and six rebounds for Delaware while Dickey finished with two assists and two steals.

LAST TIME AT JAMES MADISON | SATURDAY, MARCH 9, 2019 | JMU CONVOCATION CENTER

Delaware held its own throughout the game, but in the end, rebounding hindered the Hens in their 56-51 loss to James Madison in the regular season finale. UD led by as much as seven in the third quarter, but the Dukes (25-4, 17-1 CAA) took advantage of rebounding and free throw opportunities to claim victory. **Bailey Kargo** and **Lizzie Oleary** led the Hens with 12 points apiece while Oleary finished with a team-high seven rebounds. **Samone DeFreese** added seven points and six rebounds while **Jasmine Dickey** contributed six points and six rebounds.

GONZALES MAKES BLUE HENS HISTORY

With one 3-point field goal versus Hofstra (Jan. 10), **Abby Gonzales** became the first Blue Hen to collect 300-plus assists and 150-plus 3-point field goals in her career. She is currently fifth in program history with both 341 assists and 154 treys.

ENABOSI AND GONZALES REACH CENTURY MARK IN GAMES PLAYED

Delaware has seen two Blue Hens appear in their 100th career games this season as **Abby Gonzales** reached the century mark on December 7 at Robert Morris while **Nicole Enabosi** saw the milestone on January 3 at UNCW. Gonzales is currently 12th in program history with 3,442 minutes played (110 games) while Enabosi is 14th with 3,280 minutes played (106 games). The last Hens to reach at least 3,000 minutes played were **Erika Brown** (3,795; 124 games) and **Hannah Jardine** (3,421; 122 games) from 2013-17.

ENABOSI NAMED CAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After nearly 500 days away, **Nicole Enabosi** is starting to hit her stride and it couldn't happen at a better time for the Blue Hens. With her 20 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks in December 29's win over George Mason, Enabosi earned second CAA Player of the Week honor of the season and eighth of her illustrious career.

GONZALES HITS ASSISTS MILESTONE

Abby Gonzales became the sixth player in program history to reach 300 career assists with her 10-assist performance against Santa Clara on November 30.

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward **Nicole Enabosi** returned to the court after a nearly 16-month hiatus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 2. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year in late November. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in the 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in the previous day's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts, Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in the Nov. 30 win over Santa Clara, **Abby Gonzales** became just the third-ever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. **Sue Whiffield** (1984-88) and **Bridget McCarthy** (1987-91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

BLUE HENS ADD TARA COUSINS AND TYI SKINNER FOR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara Cousins** and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2020-21. "We're excited to welcome both Tara and Tyi into the Blue Hens family. There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

UD SLATED TO FINISH FOURTH IN CAA; DEFREES AND ENABOSI EARN PRESEASON HONORS

The Blue Hens were predicted to finish fourth in the CAA Preseason Poll. Additionally, **Nicole Enabosi** and **Samone DeFreese** were picked as Preseason All-CAA honorees. UD returns four

starters and seven letter winners from last season in addition to seeing Enabosi back on the court following ACL surgery that kept her out last year. The 2018 CAA Player of the Year, Enabosi earned Preseason First Team accolades. She finished her junior campaign ranked in the Top 10 of nine Delaware single-season categories while leading the CAA in points per game (18.0), rebounds per game (11.8) and defensive rebounds per game (8.9). A starter for the past two seasons, DeFreese was tabbed a Preseason Second Team selection. A CAA All-Second Team honoree last season, the forward the Blue Hens with 10.9 points per game and a 73.3 (77-for-105) free throw percentage.

ADAIR LEADS USA TO GOLD

In her third USA Basketball coaching experience, Delaware head coach **Natasha Adair** helped guide the Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand. Adair coached alongside Louisville head coach, Jeff Walz, and UCLA head coach, Cori Close. The trio led the 2018 USA Women's U18 National Team to a gold medal, earning the team a berth in the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.

BLUE HENS WITHOUT KARGO IN 2019-20

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as **Bailey Kargo**, one of the team's sharp-shooting leaders underwent surgery for an ACL injury.

ELENA DELLE DONNE '13 LEADS MYSTICS TO WNBA TITLE; NAMED WNBA MVP

It was a successful year for Blue Hens alumna **Elena Delle Donne** as she led the Washington Mystics to its first-ever WNBA title while becoming the first player in WNBA history to earn Most Valuable Player honors with two different teams (Chicago Sky, 2015).

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
