- » The Blue Hens look for their season-best third straight win of the season.

- » **Nicole Enabosi** continues to climb up the Delaware career record books and is currently in the Top 10 of 10 different statistical categories.
- » The 2019-20 Delaware athletics season will be a yearlong celebration of the 50th anniversary of women's athletics at the University of Delaware.

THE SERIES

- » Sunday's meeting will be the 75th all-time between the Delaware and Hofstra women's basketball programs.
- » The Blue Hens hold the all-time series advantage of 62-12 over the Pride.
- » Delaware has won 20 of the last 23 versus Hofstra.
- » The Hens are 24-10 all-time against the Pride in Hempstead and have won three straight and seven of the last eight.

THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.
- » Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.
- » **Danielle Santos Atkinson** (Florida '06) was named the 12th head coach in Hofstra women's basketball history on April 13, 2019.
- » Santos brings a total of 13 years of Division I coaching experience back to Hofstra, where she spent four seasons as an assistant coach from 2006 to 2010. Santos' career arc also includes stops at Pitt, Florida State, Kentucky and Illinois State.

LAST TIME OUT

Delaware opened the second half of Colonial Athletic Association play with an offensive explosion Friday evening as the Hens topped Northeastern, 81-69, at the Cabot Center. The Blue Hens shot a blistering 55.8 percent from the field on 29-of-52 shooting and scored their most points in regulation since November 2018. Delaware saw three players record double figure scoring efforts while each Blue Hen who played scored at least one point. A game after scoring 27 points against Towson, **Nicole Enabosi** led the way versus the Huskies with 28 points, eight rebounds, four steals, two assists and two blocked shots. **Jasmine Dickey** added her league-leading ninth double double of the season with 14 points and 13 rebounds while **Abby Gonzales** contributed 12 points of her own. Delaware opened the gates blazing and knocked down five-of-six 3-pointers in the first quarter to lead, 22-15, after 10 minutes of play. The Hens never backed down en route to their third win in four games.

LAST TIME VS. HOFSTRA | FRIDAY, JANUARY 10, 2020 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

Delaware captured its first Colonial Athletic Association victory in exciting fashion as the Blue Hens topped Hofstra, 80-59, at the Bob Carpenter Center Friday evening. In total, four Hens scored in double digits while six recorded at least four rebounds. **Jasmine Dickey** led the way by tying a career-high with 21 points while adding a season-best 16 rebounds for her sixth double double of the season. **Lizzie Cleary** and **Kayla Shaw** joined **Nicole Enabosi** with 12 points apiece. Shaw dished out her first career assist for Delaware on the team's first basket and finished the day with five. UD's 80 points was the best in regulation for the Blue Hens at that point of the season; it was also the most for the Hens since scoring 78 at Hofstra on January 18, 2019.

LAST TIME AT HOFSTRA | FRIDAY, JANUARY 18, 2019 | MACK SPORTS COMPLEX

The Blue Hens captured their first CAA victory of the season with the 78-59 decision over Hofstra. Delaware (6-10, 1-3 CAA) bounced back from three straight games of poor shooting performances to go 30-of-62 (.484) from the field for its second-highest shooting percentage of the season so far. The Blue Hens received at least two points and one rebound from every player who saw playing time while **Samone DeFreese** led the way with 19 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the floor. DeFreese added eight rebounds in the win. **Makeda Nicholas** contributed 12 points, eight rebounds and four assists while **Jasmine Dickey** logged her fourth career double double after finishing the day with 11 points and 11 rebounds.

HENS ARE HOT

Delaware's 55.8 shooting percentage against Northeastern (February 7) was the best for the Hens since shooting 58.0 percent (29-for-50) at Towson on February 2, 2014; the mark is good to tie for 11th in program single-game history.

SENIOR CLASS EXCELS ON AND OFF THE COURT

All five members of Delaware's senior class (**Samone DeFreese**, **Nicole Enabosi**, **Abby Gonzales**, **Bailey Kargo** and **Rebecca Lawrence**) all rank in the Top 25 in the Blue Hens career record books. Additionally, all five have amassed a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 during

their careers. Kargo and Lawrence have been accepted into optometry and physical therapy school, respectively, while Gonzales has already received her teaching certificate. Enabosi will complete her MBA in International Business and DeFreese also accepted a post-graduate position.

ENABOSI POSTS HISTORIC GAME VS. TOWSON

In Delaware's 69-62 win over the reigning CAA champions, **Nicole Enabosi** dropped 27 points, 16 rebounds, eight assists and three steals. Since 1996-97, there are only three players who put up a stat line up of at least 25 points, 15 rebounds and five assists. Enabosi previously collected 27/16/5 against Saint Peter's in 2017 while **Kelsey Buchanan** posted 27/15/5 versus Hofstra (2014) and **Elena Delle Donne** recorded 41/15/5 against the Pride (2012). While Enabosi barely missed the program's first-ever triple double, she did record her 47th career double double to tie with **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) for the most in school history. Additionally, Enabosi became just the third player (McNamara, Delle Donne) in Delaware history to eclipse both 1,500 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.

GONZALES MAKES BLUE HENS HISTORY

With one 3-point field goal versus Hofstra (Jan. 10), **Abby Gonzales** became the first Blue Hen to collect 300-plus assists and 150-plus 3-point field goals in her career.

ENABOSI AND GONZALES REACH CENTURY MARK IN GAMES PLAYED

Delaware has seen two Blue Hens appear in their 100th career games this season as **Abby Gonzales** reached the century mark on December 7 at Robert Morris while **Nicole Enabosi** saw the milestone on January 3 at UNCW. Gonzales is currently 12th in program history with 3,537 minutes played (113 games) while Enabosi is 15th with 3,374 minutes played (109 games). ENABOSI NAMED CAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After nearly 500 days away, **Nicole Enabosi** is starting to hit her stride and it couldn't happen at a better time for the Blue Hens. With her 20 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks in December 29's win over George Mason, Enabosi earned second CAA Player of the Week honor of the season and eighth of her illustrious career.

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward **Nicole Enabosi** returned to the court after a nearly 16-month hiatus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 2. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year in late November. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in the 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in the previous day's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts, Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in the Nov. 30 win over Santa Clara, **Abby Gonzales** became just the third-ever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. **Sue Whitfield** (1984-88) and **Bridget McCarthy** (1987-91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

BLUE HENS ADD TARA COUSINS AND TYI SKINNER FOR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara Cousins** and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2020-21. "We're excited to welcome both Tara and Tyi into the Blue Hens family. There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to

our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

UD SLATED TO FINISH FOURTH IN CAA; DEFREES AND ENABOSI EARN PRESEASON HONORS

The Blue Hens were predicted to finish fourth in the CAA Preseason Poll. Additionally, **Nicole Enabosi** and **Samone DeFreese** were picked as Preseason All-CAA honorees.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoyas program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
