THE GAME

- » Delaware hosts Elon as part of Education Day in which the Blue Hens welcome 15 local schools and approximately 3,500 students to the Bob Carpenter Center.
- » **Nicole Enabosi** continues to climb up the Delaware career record books and is currently in the Top 10 of 10 different statistical categories.
- » From now through the month of February, the Hens are competing against fellow CAA schools in the #Play4Kay National Free Throw Challenge in support of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund. For more information, please visit: <https://pledgeit.org/delaware-play4kay>
- » The 2019-20 Delaware athletics season will be a yearlong celebration of the 50th anniversary of women's athletics at the University of Delaware.

THE SERIES

- » The Phoenix lead the all-time series over the Blue Hens, 7-5, but UD has won three straight and four out of the last five against Elon.
- » In the last meeting at the Bob Carpenter Center, Delaware led wire-to-wire for the 71-59 victory on March 1, 2019.
- » Earlier this season, The Blue Hens started off rough but quickly recovered and held on for the 65-56 victory at Elon.

THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.
- » Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.
- » **Charlotte Smith** (North Carolina '99) is in her ninth year with the Phoenix and is 160-118 all-time with two CAA Tournament titles.
- » Both Adair and Smith have experience coaching with USA Basketball as the duo worked with the 2017 Women's U19 World Cup Team training camp. Adair served as a court coach while Smith was an assistant coach.

LAST TIME OUT

Jasmine Dickey continued to do what she's been doing all season with her CAA-leading 11th double-double, but it wasn't enough for the Blue Hens, who dropped a 52-32 decision to Drexel, to snap a three-game winning streak. Dickey finished with team-highs in points (12) and rebounds (12) to lead the way, while **Samone DeFreese** had five points, all in the fourth quarter. **Nicole Enabosi** added 10 more rebounds to her career total and now sits at 1,031, just 33 away from **Danielle Parker**'s program record. Delaware's defense forced 15 turnovers and limited the Dragons to just 52 points, the second-lowest point total of the season for a Blue Hen opponent. Four different players had at least two steals for the Blue Hens, which racked up double-digits (11) in steals for the eighth time this season. Delaware also outrebounded an opponent for the 16th time this season.

LAST TIME VS. ELON | SUNDAY, JANUARY 26, 2020 | SCHAR CENTER

The Blue Hens started off rough but quickly recovered and held on for the 65-56 victory at Elon. The Phoenix opened the game with the 11-2 advantage before Delaware turned things around and won three of the next four quarters to snap a three-game losing streak. **Nicole Enabosi** led all scorers with 21 points to go along with 11 rebounds for her 46th career double double, which tied her for second in program history alongside **Elena Delle Donne**. **Jasmine Dickey** added her eighth double double of the season by finishing the game with 17 points and 12 rebounds while **Kayla Shaw** also picked up 17 points, including 15 from behind the 3-point arc.

LAST TIME VS. ELON AT HOME | FRIDAY, MARCH 1, 2019 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

Each and every active Blue Hen registered key statistics as Delaware topped Elon, 71-59, at the Bob Carpenter Center. The Blue Hens, who led wire-to-wire, were guided by **Bailey Kargo**'s 16 points, which included a game-high four 3-pointers made. **Alison Lewis** collected her first career double double with 10 points and a career-best 11 rebounds. **Samone DeFreese** added 14 points and three rebounds while **Rebecca Lawrence** neared a double double of her own with 10 points and nine rebounds. In total, each Delaware player logged at least two points while five had at least four rebounds on the night.

DOUBLE DOUBLE MACHINE

Jasmine Dickey has been a consistent double double threat this season and is currently tied for seventh in program single season history with a CAA-leading 11 double doubles. **Colleen McNamara** recorded 11 during the 1994-95 campaign while **Elena Delle Donne** registered 12 as a freshman in 2009-10. **Nicole Enabosi** holds the Delaware record with 23 set as the CAA Player of the Year in 2017-18.

SENIOR CLASS EXCELS ON AND OFF THE COURT

All five members of Delaware's senior class (**Samone DeFreese**, **Nicole Enabosi**, **Abby Gonzales**, **Bailey Kargo** and **Rebecca Lawrence**) all rank in the Top 25 in the Blue Hens career record books. Additionally, all five have amassed a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 during

their careers. Kargo and Lawrence have been accepted into optometry and physical therapy school, respectively, while Gonzales has already received her teaching certificate. Enabosi will complete her MBA in International Business and DeFreese also accepted a post-graduate position.

HENS ARE HOT

Delaware's 55.8 shooting percentage against Northeastern (February 7) was the best for the Hens since shooting 58.0 percent (29-for-50) at Towson on February 2, 2014; the mark is good to tie for 11th in program single-game history.

ENABOSI POSTS HISTORIC GAME VS. TOWSON

In Delaware's 69-62 win over the reigning CAA champions, **Nicole Enabosi** dropped 27 points, 16 rebounds, eight assists and three steals. Since 1996-97, there are only three players who put up a stat line up of at least 25 points, 15 rebounds and five assists. Enabosi previously collected 27/16/5 against Saint Peter's in 2017 while **Kelsey Buchanan** posted 27/15/5 versus Hofstra (2014) and **Elena Delle Donne** recorded 41/15/5 against the Pride (2012). While Enabosi barely missed the program's first-ever triple double, she did record her 47th career double double to tie with **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) for the most in school history. Additionally, Enabosi became just the third player (McNamara, Delle Donne) in Delaware history to eclipse both 1,500 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.

ENABOSI AND GONZALES REACH CENTURY MARK IN GAMES PLAYED

Delaware has seen two Blue Hens appear in their 100th career games this season as **Abby Gonzales** reached the century mark on December 7 at Robert Morris while **Nicole Enabosi** saw the milestone on January 3 at UNCW. Gonzales is currently 11th in program history with 3,592 minutes played (115 games) while Enabosi is 14th with 3,430 minutes played (111 games). The last Hens to reach at least 3,000 minutes played were **Erika Brown** (3,795; 124 games) and **Hannah Jardine** (3,421; 122 games) from 2013-17.

DELAWARE PARTICIPATING IN #PLAY4KAY FREE THROW CHALLENGE

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward **Nicole Enabosi** returned to the court after a nearly 16-month hiatus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 2. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year in late November. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in the 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in the previous day's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts, Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in the Nov. 30 win over Santa Clara, **Abby Gonzales** became just the third-ever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. **Sue Whitfield** (1984-88) and **Bridget McCarthy** (1987-91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara Cousins** and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens

Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
