THE GAME

» Delaware travels to Towson and James Madison for its final regular season road trip.

» **Nicole Enabosi** continues to climb up the Delaware career record books and is currently in the Top 10 of 10 different statistical categories.

» **Nicole Enabosi's** 1,054 career rebounds is just 10 away from tying **Danielle Parker's** school record of 1,064 career rebounds set from 2008-13. Her 1,054 rebounds are also good for 10th in CAA history.

THE SERIES

» One of the longest rivalries in program history, today's game is the 81st all-time game between the two teams dating to the 1973-74 season.

» Delaware leads Towson all-time, 57-23, and has won 18 of the last 20 vs. the Tigers.

» The Blue Hens are 27-11 against TU in Towson and have won four straight on the road versus the Tigers.

» Earlier this month, UD topped TU, 69-62, in the team's annual #Play4Kay pink game at the Bob Carpenter Center.

THE COACHES

» **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

» Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.

» Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.

» **Diane Richardson** (Frostburg '80), the 2019 CAA Coach of the Year, is in her third season as the head coach at Towson.

LAST TIME OUT

Delaware saw two players post double-doubles Sunday afternoon, but it wasn't enough as William & Mary picked up the 78-60 victory over the Hens at the Bob Carpenter Center. On her 20th birthday, **Jasmine Dickey** led UD with 17 points and 10 rebounds. **Nicole Enabosi** added her 49th career double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds while **Samone DeFreese** neared one of her own with 13 points and nine rebounds. The Hens outrebounded an opponent for the 18th time this season.

LAST TIME VS. TOWSON | SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2020 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

Nicole Enabosi showed why she's one of the best players in program history as she guided the Blue Hens to a 69-62 victory over the defending CAA Champion Towson Tigers at the Bob Carpenter Center. Not only did the forward capture her record-tying 47th career double-double, Enabosi also eclipsed the 1,500 points and 1,000 rebounds milestones while falling just short of the program's first-ever triple-double with 27 points, 16 rebounds and eight assists. With her totals, she became just the third-ever Blue Hen to reach at least 1,500 points and 1,000 rebounds next to **Elena Delle Donne** (2009-13) and **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95). **Jasmine Dickey** added 17 points and nine rebounds for the Hens while **Abby Gonzales** posted 11 points and **Samone DeFreese** collected seven points and 10 rebounds. Both Delaware and Towson won two quarters of play, but the Blue Hens took the lead for good in the third quarter and went up by as much as 12 the final stanza.

LAST TIME AT TOWSON | THURSDAY, MARCH 7, 2019 | SECU ARENA

A 27-point fourth quarter sparked Delaware to its third straight win as the Hens topped Towson, 70-57. The Blue Hens (16-13, 11-6 CAA), who trailed by one entering the fourth quarter, outscored the Tigers, 27-13, in the final stanza. **Makeda Nicholas** led Delaware with 15 points, six rebounds and three assists while **Alison Lewis** tallied 14 points, five rebounds and two assists. **Jasmine Dickey**, who missed the previous seven games with a broken hand, returned to the floor where she led Catonsville High School to the 2017 Maryland state title to collect eight points and three rebounds in 11 minutes of action.

ENABOSI MOVING IN ON CAREER REBOUNDING RECORD

With her 12 boards versus the Tribe, Enabosi is now just 10 away from tying **Danielle Parker's** school record of 1,064 career rebounds set from 2008-13. Her 1,054 rebounds are also good for 10th in Colonial Athletic Association history.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Jasmine Dickey has been a consistent double-double threat this season and is currently tied for sixth in program single season history with a CAA-leading 12 double-doubles. **Elena Delle Donne** registered 12 as a freshman in 2009-10 while Christina Rible (2000-01) is fifth with 15. **Nicole Enabosi** holds the Delaware record with 23 set as the CAA Player of the Year in 2017-18.

for the Hens since shooting 58.0 percent (29-for-50) at Towson on February 2, 2014; the mark is good to tie for 11th in program single-game history. The Blue Hens followed with another 55.8 shooting percentage (24-43) at home against Elon on February 21.

SENIOR CLASS EXCELS ON AND OFF THE COURT

All five members of Delaware's senior class (**Samone DeFreese**, **Nicole Enabosi**, **Abby Gonzales**, **Bailey Kargo** and **Rebecca Lawrence**) all rank in the Top 25 in the Blue Hens career record books. Additionally, all five have amassed a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 during their careers. Kargo and Lawrence have been accepted into optometry and physical therapy school, respectively, while Gonzales has already received her teaching certificate. Enabosi will complete her MBA in International Business and DeFreese also accepted a post-graduate position.

ENABOSI POSTS HISTORIC GAME VS. TOWSON

In Delaware's 69-62 win over the reigning CAA champions, **Nicole Enabosi** dropped 27 points, 16 rebounds, eight assists and three steals. Since 1996-97, there are only three players who put up a stat line up of at least 25 points, 15 rebounds and five assists. Enabosi previously collected 27/16/5 against Saint Peter's in 2017 while **Kelsey Buchanan** posted 27/15/5 versus Hofstra (2014) and **Elena Delle Donne** recorded 41/15/5 against the Pride (2012). While Enabosi barely missed the program's first-ever triple double, she did record her 47th career double double to tie with **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) for the most in school history. Additionally, Enabosi became just the third player (McNamara, Delle Donne) in Delaware history to eclipse both 1,500 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.

ENABOSI AND GONZALES REACH CENTURY MARK IN GAMES PLAYED

Delaware has seen two Blue Hens appear in their 100th career games this season as **Abby Gonzales** reached the century mark on December 7 at Robert Morris while **Nicole Enabosi** saw the milestone on January 3 at UNCW. Gonzales is currently 10th in program history with 3,652 minutes played (117 games) while Enabosi is 13th with 3,501 minutes played (113 games). The last Hens to reach at least 3,000 minutes played were **Erika Brown** (3,795; 124 games) and **Hannah Jardine** (3,421; 122 games) from 2013-17.

GONZALES MAKES BLUE HENS HISTORY

With one 3-point field goal versus Hofstra (Jan. 10), **Abby Gonzales** became the first Blue Hen to collect 300-plus assists and 150-plus 3-point field goals in her career.

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward **Nicole Enabosi** returned to the court after a nearly 16-month hiatus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 2. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year in late November. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in the 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in the previous day's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts, Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in the Nov. 30 win over Santa Clara, **Abby Gonzales** became just the third-ever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. **Sue Whitfield** (1984-88) and **Bridget McCarthy** (1987-91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

BLUE HENS ADD TARA COUSINS AND TYI SKINNER FOR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara**

Cousins and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2020-21. "We're excited to welcome both Tara and Tyi into the Blue Hens family. There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

UD SLATED TO FINISH FOURTH IN CAA; DEFREESE AND ENABOSI EARN PRESEASON HONORS

The Blue Hens were predicted to finish fourth in the CAA Preseason Poll. Additionally, **Nicole Enabosi** and **Samone DeFreese** were picked as Preseason All-CAA honorees.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
