THE GAME

- » Delaware takes on James Madison in its final regular season road game.
- » **Nicole Enabosi** continues to climb up the Delaware career record books and is currently in the Top 10 of 10 different statistical categories.
- » **Nicole Enabosi** broke the Delaware school record Friday at Towson and is now ninth all-time in CAA history with 1,066 career rebounds.

THE SERIES

- » This is the 41st meeting between Delaware and James Madison in women's basketball history.
- » The Dukes have won 15 straight over the Blue Hens and lead the all-time series, 27-13.
- » Delaware is 5-12 against James Madison in Harrisonburg.
- » The Hens last defeated the Dukes, 61-60, on February 24, 2013 at the Bob Carpenter Center.

THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.
- » Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.
- » **Sean O'Regan** (James Madison '03) is in his fourth season as the head coach at James Madison. O'Regan previously served the previous nine seasons as an assistant and associate head coach for the Dukes.

LAST TIME OUT

Finishing the game with her 50th career double-double, **Nicole Enabosi** broke Delaware's all-time rebounding record in Friday's 76-66 loss to Towson at SECU Arena. The graduate student needed 10 to tie and 11 to break **Danielle Parker**'s mark of 1,064 from 2008-13 and wrapped play against the Tigers with 12 rebounds to go along with 17 points in 35 minutes of action. Enabosi's 1,066 career boards is also good for ninth in Colonial Athletic Association history. **Samone DeFreeze** added a double-double of her own with 12 points and 10 rebounds while **Jasmine Dickey** contributed 10 rebounds, seven points and a career-high five steals. The first half proved to be a back-and-forth affair with the two teams going into the break tied at 27. Towson took charge in the third quarter and carried that momentum through the end of the game for the win.

LAST TIME VS. JAMES MADISON | FRIDAY, JANUARY 31, 2020 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

The shots were not falling for the Blue Hens as James Madison posted the 60-39 victory over Delaware at the Bob Carpenter Center. The Hens, who neared a season-high with 72 field goal attempts, registered a season-low 16 field goals made for a 22.2 shooting percentage from the floor. Delaware outrebounded the Dukes, 49-41, including a 26-9 margin on offensive boards. **Jasmine Dickey** posted a game-high 15 rebounds to go along with team-highs of eight points and three assists.

LAST TIME AT JAMES MADISON | SATURDAY, MARCH 9, 2019 | JMU CONVOCATION CENTER

Delaware held its own throughout the game, but in the end, rebounding hindered the Hens in their 56-51 loss to James Madison in the regular season finale. UD led by as much as seven in the third quarter, but the Dukes (25-4, 17-1 CAA) took advantage of rebounding and free throw opportunities to claim victory. **Bailey Kargo** and **Lizzie Oleary** led the Hens with 12 points apiece while Oleary finished with a team-high seven rebounds. **Samone DeFreeze** added seven points and six rebounds while Jasmine Dickey contributed six points and six rebounds.

ENABOSI BREAKS CAREER REBOUNDING RECORD

With her 12 boards versus at Towson, **Nicole Enabosi** bypassed both **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) and **Danielle Parker** (2008-13) into first place in program history with 1,066 career rebounds. McNamara finished her career with 1,063 while Parker posted 1,064 during her tenure.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Jasmine Dickey has been a consistent double-double threat this season and is currently tied for sixth in program single season history with a CAA-leading 12 double-doubles. **Elena Delle Donne** registered 12 as a freshman in 2009-10 while Christina Rible (2000-01) is fifth with 15. **Nicole Enabosi** holds the Delaware record with 23 set as the CAA Player of the Year in 2017-18.

There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

UD SLATED TO FINISH FOURTH IN CAA; DEFREESE AND ENABOSI EARN PRESEASON HONORS

The Blue Hens were predicted to finish fourth in the CAA Preseason Poll. Additionally, **Nicole Enabosi** and **Samone DeFreese** were picked as Preseason All-CAA honorees.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
