THE GAME

» UD welcomes UNCW for the final game of the regular season.

» **Nicole Enabosi** broke the Delaware school record last Friday at Towson and is now ninth all-time in CAA history with 1,082 career rebounds.

» **Nicole Enabosi** is currently in third place in Delaware history with 1,655 career points. Cindy Johnson (1997-01) is second all-time with 1,675 points while Elena Delle Donne (2009-13) holds the school record with 3,039.

» The Blue Hens will honor seniors **Samone DeFreese, Nicole Enabosi, Bailey Kargo, Abby Gonzales and Rebecca Lawrence** prior to the game.

THE SERIES

» Delaware leads the all-time series with UNCW, 28-10, since the first meeting in 2001-02.

» UD has won 16 of the last 19 versus the Seahawks.

» The Blue Hens are 14-3 all-time when playing UNCW in Newark.

» The two teams coincidentally opened CAA play against each other on January 3. The Seahawks pulled out the 71-65 overtime win.

THE COACHES

» **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

» Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.

» Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.

» **Karen Barefoot** (Christopher Newport '95) is in her third season as the head coach at UNCW after six successful years at Old Dominion.

LAST TIME OUT

Rebecca Lawrence broke the school's single-game blocks record Thursday evening as the Blue Hens defeated Charleston, 63-54, at the Bob Carpenter Center. Lawrence finished the game with 10 blocked shots to best **Colleen McNamara**'s mark of eight set against Lehigh on January 5, 1994. Delaware also had three players register double doubles in the win in **Samone DeFreese** (20 points, 11 rebounds), **Nicole Enabosi** (16/13) and **Jasmine Dickey** (15/12). The Blue Hens struggled for the first 14 minutes or so of the contest before a spark was lit. Delaware finished the second quarter on a 14-3 run and continued that momentum into the third. The Hens led by as much as 17 in the contest and held the Cougars to a 27.3 field goal percentage, which is the lowest opponent mark in CAA play this season.

LAST TIME VS. UNCW | FRIDAY, JANUARY 3, 2020 | TRASK COLISEUM

They knew it was going to be a dogfight and, in the end, it was just that as the Blue Hens came up on the wrong end of Friday's Colonial Athletic Association opener at UNCW by an overtime score of 71-65. **Nicole Enabosi** led all scorers with 23 points to go along with a team-best eight rebounds. Another bright spot for Delaware was **Kayla Shaw**, who collected 17 points, including five 3-pointers, as she returned to the court after missing 10 games with a concussion. UD jumped out to an early lead but gave way to the Seahawks in the second and third quarters before inching back into things in the fourth. Shaw knocked down three straight 3-pointers to give the Hens a two-point advantage with 1:28 remaining in regulation. UNCW regained the lead at 61-59 with 13 seconds left before Enabosi collected the right-handed bunny to send things into overtime. Gigi Smith captured all 10 of UNCW's points in the extra stanza to seal the win.

LAST TIME VS. UNCW AT HOME | FRIDAY, JANUARY 25, 2019 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

A 26-point performance from **Samone DeFreese** sparked Delaware in its 65-53 victory over UNCW. DeFreese shot 10-of-19 (.526) from the floor while going a perfect 6-for-6 from the charity stripe to record a career day. The forward added a season-best 11 points for her seventh career double double – and the first of the season. **Makeda Nicholas** also saw double figures with 11 points while **Alison Lewis** contributed eight points for the Hens (7-11, 2-4 CAA). In a game that saw six lead changes and four tied scores, the two teams held a 28-28 stalemate at the half. DeFreese changed the story and gave the Blue Hens the lead for good with the second half's first basket just 20 seconds in. The Blue Hens held advantages in rebounds (43-37), blocked shots (5-0) and steals (11-2).

LAWRENCE HOLDS SCHOOL-RECORD-BREAKING BLOCKS PARTY

Rebecca Lawrence had quite the performance in Delaware's win over Charleston on March 5. The senior finished the game with a school-record 10 blocked shots to best **Colleen McNamara**'s mark of eight set against Lehigh on January 5, 1994. Her total was one short of the Colonial Athletic Association single-game record.

(1991-95) and **Danielle Parker** (2008-13) into first place in program history with 1,066 career rebounds. McNamara finished her career with 1,063 while Parker posted 1,064 during her tenure.

TRIO REACH CENTURY MARK IN GAMES PLAYED

Delaware has seen three Blue Hens appear in their 100th career games this season in **Abby Gonzales** (Dec. 7 at Robert Morris), **Nicole Enabosi** (Jan. 3 at UNCW) and **Samone DeFreese** (March 1 at James Madison). Gonzales is currently eighth in program history with 3,734 minutes played (120 games) while Enabosi is 12th with 3,601 minutes played (116 games). The last Hens to reach at least 3,000 minutes played were **Erika Brown** (3,795; 124 games) and **Hannah Jardine** (3,421; 122 games) from 2013-17.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Jasmine Dickey has been a consistent double-double threat this season and is currently sixth in program single season history with a CAA-leading 13 double-doubles. **Elena Delle Donne** registered 12 as a freshman in 2009-10 while Christina Rible (2000-01) is fifth with 15. **Nicole Enabosi** holds the Delaware record with 23 set as the CAA Player of the Year in 2017-18.

SENIOR CLASS EXCELS ON AND OFF THE COURT

All five members of Delaware's senior class (**Samone DeFreese**, **Nicole Enabosi**, **Abby Gonzales**, **Bailey Kargo** and **Rebecca Lawrence**) all rank in the Top 25 in the Blue Hens career record books. Additionally, all five have amassed a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 during their careers. Kargo and Lawrence have been accepted into optometry and physical therapy school, respectively, while Gonzales has already received her teaching certificate. Enabosi will complete her MBA in International Business and DeFreese also accepted a post-graduate position.

HENS FROM THE FIELD

Delaware's 55.8 shooting percentage (29-52) against Northeastern (February 7) was the best for the Hens since shooting 58.0 percent (29-for-50) at Towson on February 2, 2014; the mark is good to tie for 11th in program single-game history. The Blue Hens followed with another 55.8 shooting percentage (24-43) at home against Elon on February 21.

ENABOSI POSTS HISTORIC GAME VS. TOWSON

In Delaware's 69-62 win over the reigning CAA champions on February 2, **Nicole Enabosi** dropped 27 points, 16 rebounds, eight assists and three steals. Since 1996-97, there are only three players who put up a stat line up of at least 25 points, 15 rebounds and five assists. Enabosi previously collected 27/16/5 against Saint Peter's in 2017 while **Kelsey Buchanan** posted 27/15/5 versus Hofstra (2014) and **Elena Delle Donne** recorded 41/15/5 against the Pride (2012). While Enabosi barely missed the program's first-ever triple double, she did record her 47th career double double to tie with **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) for the most in school history. Additionally, Enabosi became just the third player (McNamara, Delle Donne) in Delaware history to eclipse both 1,500 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.

GONZALES MAKES BLUE HENS HISTORY

With one 3-point field goal versus Hofstra (Jan. 10), **Abby Gonzales** became the first Blue Hen to collect 300-plus assists and 150-plus 3-point field goals in her career.

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward **Nicole Enabosi** returned to the court after a nearly 16-month hiatus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 2. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year in late November. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in the 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in the previous day's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts, Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in the Nov. 30 win over Santa Clara, **Abby Gonzales** became just the third-ever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. **Sue Whitfield** (1984-88) and **Bridget McCarthy** (1987-91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

BLUE HENS ADD TARA COUSINS AND TYI SKINNER FOR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara Cousins** and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2020-21. "We're excited to welcome both Tara and Tyi into the Blue Hens family. There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

Adair coached alongside Louisville head coach, Jeff Walz, and UCLA head coach, Cori Close. The trio led the 2018 USA Women's U18 National Team to a gold medal, earning the team a berth in the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.

BLUE HENS WITHOUT KARGO IN 2019-20

The Blue Hens were dealt a blow to the roster during the offseason as **Bailey Kargo**, one of the team's sharp-shooting leaders underwent surgery for an ACL injury.

ELENA DELLE DONNE '13 LEADS MYSTICS TO WNBA TITLE; NAMED WNBA MVP

It was a successful year for Blue Hens alumna **Elena Delle Donne** as she led the Washington Mystics to its first-ever WNBA title while becoming the first player in WNBA history to earn Most Valuable Player honors with two different teams (Chicago Sky, 2015).

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
