THE GAME

- » Sixth-seeded Delaware opens postseason play with a quarterfinals matchup against third-seeded William & Mary.
- » Thursday's pairing is just the second-ever matchup between the Blue Hens and Tribe in the CAA Tournament.
- » UD is 25-16 all-time in the CAA Tournament and 14-2 in the quarterfinals round.

» **Nicole Enabosi** earned All-CAA First Team Team honors while **Jasmine Dickey** was named to the Second Team and All-Defensive Team.

» **Nicole Enabosi** is currently in the Top 12 of 12 statistical categories in the Delaware career record books.

THE SERIES

- » Delaware leads the all-time series against William & Mary, 26-10, and has won eight of the last 11 regular season contests.
- » The Tribe have won two straight over the Hens.
- » The Blue Hens hold the neutral court advantage at 2-1.
- » William & Mary picked up the win in the lone CAA Tournament matchup between the two teams with a 59-44 decision in the 2017 CAA Tournament quarterfinals at the JMU Convocation Center.

THE COACHES

- » **Natasha Adair** (South Florida '94) is in her third season at UD after being named just the fourth women's basketball coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.
- » Now in her eighth season overall, Adair recorded her 100th career victory as a head coach during the 2018-19 campaign.
- » Adair is heavily involved with USA Basketball and most recently helped guide Team USA U19 squad to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA Women's World Cup in Thailand as an assistant coach.
- » **Ed Swanson** (Sacred Heart '89) is in his seventh season at William & Mary and 30th overall as a head coach.

LAST TIME OUT

The Blue Hens were not going to let their senior class walk off the Bob Carpenter Center floor for the last time without a win. And they did not disappoint Saturday afternoon with their 61-57 victory over UNCW. With the win, Delaware clinched a first-round bye in the CAA Tournament as the No. 6 seed. The Hens started off slow, but a 39-point second half and 22-point fourth quarter gave Delaware the momentum in the waning minutes. The Seahawks pulled things within one with 26 seconds remaining in regulation, but the Blue Hens hit three free throws, including two from **Paris McBride** in the final seven seconds, to seal the win. **Nicole Enabosi** led Delaware with 21 points and in the process moved into second place in the Blue Hens record books with 1,676 career points behind only All-American **Elena Delle Donne**. Enabosi also contributed a game-high 15 rebounds for her 52nd career double double. **Samone DeFreese** added 14 points and six rebounds of her own while **Jasmine Dickey** collected 10 points. McBride finished the day with six points and six assists with zero turnovers.

LAST TIME VS. WILLIAM & MARY | SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2020 | BOB CARPENTER CENTER

Delaware saw two players post double-doubles, but it wasn't enough as William & Mary picked up the 78-60 victory over the Hens at the Bob Carpenter Center. On her 20th birthday, Jasmine Dickey led UD with 17 points and 10 rebounds. **Nicole Enabosi** added her 49th career double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds while **Samone DeFreese** neared one of her own with 13 points and nine rebounds.

LAST TIME AT WILLIAM & MARY | FRIDAY, JANUARY 24, 2020 | KAPLAN ARENA

The Hens dug themselves a hole in the first quarter and were unable to turn things around in their 68-58 loss at William & Mary. Delaware was outscored, 21-10, in the first 10 minutes of the game and tied the Tribe in the second and fourth quarters while holding a one-point advantage in the third. The Hens came out of the halftime break roaring and cut the lead to four in the third quarter, but William & Mary never let up. **Jasmine Dickey** and **Nicole Enabosi** led Delaware with 18 points apiece. Dickey added nine rebounds and four assists while **Lizzie Oleary** contributed eight points and seven rebounds of her own.

LAST TIME VS. WILLIAM & MARY IN THE CAA TOURNAMENT THURSDAY, MARCH 9, 2017 | CAA QUARTERFINALS | JMU CONVOCATION CENTER

For the first time in eight years, the Blue Hens didn't advance to the CAA Tournament semifinals as Delaware fell to William & Mary, 59-44, in the CAA quarterfinals matchup at the JMU Convocation Center. Delaware, which was previously 13-0 in CAA quarterfinals appearances and had made seven straight trips to the semis, struggled on the boards and was just one rebound away from a season-low with 26 rebounds. The fourth-seeded Tribe (20-10) jumped out to an early lead, and while the fifth-seeded Hens held it close for the majority of the game, UD (16-14) was never able overcome deficit. **Erika Brown** led the Blue Hens with 15 points and three assists. **Makeda Nicholas** added 10 points and five rebounds while **Nicole Enabosi** finished the game with seven points, five rebounds and a career-best five steals.

BLUE HENS GARNER POSTSEASON ACCOLADES

Earlier this week, **Nicole Enabosi** received First Team All-CAA honors for the third time in her career while **Jasmine Dickey** was named to the Second Team and All-Defensive Team for the first time. Enabosi enters postseason play ranked fifth in the CAA with 17.1 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Enabosi will go down as one of the best players in program history as she is ranked in the Top 12

of 12 different statistical categories. Dickey, who was an All-Rookie Team selection a season ago, leads Delaware with 9.2 rebounds per game and is second with 12.4 per. Her marks are good for second and 13th in the conference, respectively. She also guides the Hens with 1.8 steals and 32.6 minutes played per contest.

ENABOSI MOVES UP IN CAREER RECORD BOOKS

With her 21 points against UNCW (March 7), **Nicole Enabosi** moved into second place in the Blue Hens record books with 1,676 career points behind only All-American **Elena Delle Donne**, who finished her career fifth in the NCAA record books with 3,039 points. **Cindy Johnson** (1997-01) was previously second all-time with 1,675 points.

ENABOSI BREAKS CAREER REBOUNDING RECORD

With her 12 boards versus at Towson, **Nicole Enabosi** bypassed both **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) and **Danielle Parker** (2008-13) into first place in program history with 1,066 career rebounds. McNamara finished her career with 1,063 while Parker posted 1,064 during her tenure. Enabosi is currently eighth in CAA history with 1,097 boards. Her mark is also good for 10th amongst all active NCAA Division I players.

LAWRENCE HOLDS SCHOOL-RECORD-BREAKING BLOCKS PARTY

Rebecca Lawrence had quite the performance in Delaware's win over Charleston on March 5. The senior finished the game with a school-record 10 blocked shots to best **Colleen McNamara's** mark of eight set against Lehigh on January 5, 1994. Her total was one short of the Colonial Athletic Association single-game record.

TRIO REACH CENTURY MARK IN GAMES PLAYED

Delaware has seen three Blue Hens appear in their 100th career games this season in **Abby Gonzales** (Dec. 7 at Robert Morris), **Nicole Enabosi** (Jan. 3 at UNCW) and **Samone DeFreese** (March 1 at James Madison). Gonzales is currently seventh in program history with 3,757 minutes played (121 games) while Enabosi is 11th with 3,641 minutes played (116 games). The last Hens to reach at least 3,000 minutes played were **Erika Brown** (3,795; 124 games) and **Hannah Jardine** (3,421; 122 games) from 2013-17.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Jasmine Dickey has been a consistent double-double threat this season and is currently sixth in program single season history with a CAA-leading 13 double-doubles. **Elena Delle Donne** registered 12 as a freshman in 2009-10 while Christina Rible (2000-01) is fifth with 15. **Nicole Enabosi** holds the Delaware record with 23 set as the CAA Player of the Year in 2017-18.

SENIOR CLASS EXCELS ON AND OFF THE COURT

All five members of Delaware's senior class (**Samone DeFreese**, **Nicole Enabosi**, **Abby Gonzales**, **Bailey Kargo** and **Rebecca Lawrence**) all rank in the Top 25 in the Blue Hens career record books. Additionally, all five have amassed a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 during their careers. Kargo and Lawrence have been accepted into optometry and physical therapy school, respectively, while Gonzales has already received her teaching certificate. Enabosi will complete her MBA in International Business and DeFreese also accepted a post-graduate position.

ENABOSI POSTS HISTORIC GAME VS. TOWSON

In Delaware's 69-62 win over the reigning CAA champions on February 2, **Nicole Enabosi** dropped 27 points, 16 rebounds, eight assists and three steals. Since 1996-97, there are only three players who put up a stat line up of at least 25 points, 15 rebounds and five assists. Enabosi previously collected 27/16/5 against Saint Peter's in 2017 while **Kelsey Buchanan** posted 27/15/5 versus Hofstra (2014) and **Elena Delle Donne** recorded 41/15/5 against the Pride (2012). While Enabosi barely missed the program's first-ever triple double, she did record her 47th career double double to tie with **Colleen McNamara** (1991-95) for the most in school history. Additionally, Enabosi became just the third player (McNamara, Delle Donne) in Delaware history to eclipse both 1,500 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.

GONZALES MAKES BLUE HENS HISTORY

With one 3-point field goal versus Hofstra (Jan. 10), **Abby Gonzales** became the first Blue Hen to collect 300-plus assists and 150-plus 3-point field goals in her career.

ENABOSI RETURNS TO BLUE HENS IN DRAMATIC FASHION

Blue Hens forward **Nicole Enabosi** returned to the court after a nearly 16-month hiatus and promptly returned to her old ways as the 2018 Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 2. Enabosi, who missed all of last season and the first four games of this season due to an ACL injury, averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals while leading Delaware to its first two wins of the year in late November. The Gaithersburg, Md. native led the Hens with a career-high 32 points to go along with eight rebounds in the 81-80 overtime victory against Santa Clara. Enabosi opened her year with 13 points in 17 minutes of action in the previous day's win over Cal State Fullerton. For her efforts, Enabosi was named to the Titan Classic All-Tournament Team.

GONZALES DROPS DOUBLE-DIGIT DIMES

With 10 assists in the Nov. 30 win over Santa Clara, **Abby Gonzales** became just the third-ever Blue Hen to record at least 10 assists in a single game multiple times in her career. She previously dished out 10 assists versus Boston University on November 19, 2017. **Sue Whitfield** (1984-88) and **Bridget McCarthy** (1987-91) each posted three 10-plus assist games during their four-year careers.

BLUE HENS ADD TARA COUSINS AND TYI SKINNER FOR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Delaware women's basketball head coach **Natasha Adair** excitedly announced that **Tara Cousins** and **Tyi Skinner** have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Blue Hens beginning in 2020-21. "We're excited to welcome both Tara and Tyi into the Blue Hens family. There aren't enough attributes to discuss the positives that both will bring with them. Kudos to our current players for building the current culture of our program and I know that Tara and Tyi will really complement what we're doing. I cannot wait to see them in blue and gold, and just to see their impact felt as soon as they get here." Cousins, a 5-8 guard from Washington, D.C., averaged 22.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game as a junior last season at Woodrow Wilson High School. The 2019 DCIAA Player of the Year, Cousins transferred to New Hope Academy for her senior campaign. NHA is ranked as the top girl's high school program in the country by USA Today and also produced current Delaware freshman Agnes Paul. A 5-5 guard from Washington, D.C., Skinner transferred to TPLS Christian Academy midway through her junior season where she averaged 25 points per game, 8.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

ADAIR LEADS USA TO GOLD

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season. Enabosi finished her junior year by overtaking the Blue Hens single-season records in rebounds (375) and double-doubles (23) while her name is littered among the Delaware single-season Top 10 for points, points per game, rebounds per game, blocked shots, field goals made, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
